

Schedule C:
Rules of Co-option to meetings of the Union and its Standing
Committees

1. Where co-option is permitted by the terms of reference of any meeting of the Union and its Standing Committees, the following rules shall apply:
 - (a) co-option shall be by a simple majority of the voting membership;
 - (b) co-option may be terminated by a simple majority of the voting membership;
 - (c) co-option may not be used to fill casual vacancies in the voting membership;
 - (d) the number of co-optees may not exceed 25% (twenty-five percent) of the voting membership;
 - (e) co-optees must be able to make a valid contribution to the remit of the meeting or Standing Committee;
 - (f) co-optees shall not have voting rights.
