

CITY UNIVERSITY STUDENTS' UNION **CONSTITUTION**

Section A : Name and Object

1. There shall be a Students' Union as prescribed in the Charter of City University, the name of which shall be "City University Students' Union", and it shall be referred to as "the Union" throughout this Constitution.

2. The objects of the Union shall be to:
 - (a) Act as the official organisation representing all students attending courses of study at the University other than those who elect not to be a member.
 - (b) (i) Develop and foster the cultural, intellectual, social and athletic recreation of students;
(ii) Develop and foster the education and welfare of students.
 - (c) Endeavour to provide such services as may from time to time be required by the student body.
 - (d) Develop and foster amongst its members the formation of Clubs and Societies having the objects described in (b)(i) above, and such Clubs and Societies when formed may become affiliated to the Union.
