

Regulation K: Amendment

11.1 Amendments to the Constitution

The text of this Constitution may be amended by the UC, subject to the following:

- (a) Notice of submission of business and availability of the agenda shall be as provided for in Schedule A and Schedule B to this Constitution.
- (b) The agenda includes the details of the proposed changes.
- (c) A two-thirds majority vote by those present and eligible to vote at an UC meeting or EUGM.
- (d) UC confirming its two-thirds majority vote at a second meeting of SRC by a simple majority vote no sooner than 30 days after the meeting at which the amendments were made.
- (e) Approval by University Council.

Any proposed amendment to the Constitution having been decided shall not be raised again for a period of two years from the date of that decision. This sub-section may be suspended only by a seven-eighths majority vote at a meeting of the UC or EUGM.

11.2 Amendments to the Regulations, Schedules, and Standing Orders of this Constitution

- (a) The text of the Regulations, Schedules and Standing Orders, may be amended by the UC as detailed in **11.1 (a), (b) and (c)** above. **11.1 (d) and (e)** do not apply.
- (b) Any proposed amendment to the Regulations, Schedules and Standing Orders having been decided shall not be raised again for a period of twelve months from the date of that decision. This sub-section may be suspended only by a seven-eighths majority vote of the UC or EUGM.
- (c) Any amendment to the Regulations, Schedules and Standing Orders shall be reported to the University Secretary within one week of the meeting at which it is approved. The amendment will not come into affect until after the report has been made.

11.3 Interpretation of the Constitution

The UC shall be responsible for the interpretation of the Constitution, through the elected Chair of UC. In the event of a dispute the President will consult the University Secretary who may place the matter before the Chair of University Council for a ruling, which shall be final.
