CONSTITUTION

Section F : Equal Opportunities and Freedom of Speech

1. The Union shall be committed to equal opportunities in all its activities. All members, staff and visitors shall at all times receive equal treatment irrespective of political belief, gender, sexual orientation, age, disability, marital status, race, nationality, ethnic origin, religion and social background.
2. The Union shall be independent of any political party or religious body and shall be committed to freedom of speech within the law. In this respect the Union recognises its responsibilities under the terms of the University's Code of Practice made in accordance with the Education (No2) Act 1986 Section 43 or any subsequent statutory amendment.
